Dear Sir / Madam:

I write to oppose the above application for the erection of three dwellings, associated parking and provision of vehicular passing areas at Blair House, Walsall Road, Lichfield, Staffordshire. I base the objection on the following:

- the original Section 106 agreement for this estate clearly showing Blair house as public open space
- the written promise from a senior planning officer that the site would remain public open space
- the improper procedure by our council for changing the agreement (no public notice ever given)
- the danger to the approximately 100 pedestrians & children who travel the proposed single-lane, shared-access path to/fro the local schools many of them with prams, pushchairs, bicycles, scooters, etc. (which is nowadays encouraged by the county council!).
- the fact that this proposed development is ill-planned (vehicular access should have been better planned) due to it never being part of the original plans for this development in the first place
- and finally that it is questionable whether the left turning off Walsall road onto the lane meets highway code
